## What is RAMS

RAMS is a non profit, non government, community, peer based male sexworker representative organisation.

Our members come from all areas of the Sex Industry including street workers, parlour boys, private workers, escorts, courtesans, blue boys and strippers.

RAMS was founded in the late 1980's by Robin Svendsjaryd and a group of currently working male sexworkers as an instrument to provide a strong voice for male sexworkers, to provide peer run, grass roots service delivery programs to male workers in the sex industry, to ensure that male sexworkers were adequately and equitably serviced within society, and to actively oppose bigotry, intolerance, inequality, discrimination, violence and stigmatisation of all kinds and on all levels.

RAMS has grown to be the most dynamic and innovative force in Sex Industry politics, being the first of its kind any where in the world, and unfortunately, the only active sexworker representative organisation in the State.

RAMS membership is free and completely confidential.

Our disclosure policy is based on pro choice.

RAMS make it clear that we do not in any way claim to represent, or speak on behalf of female, transsexual, transgender, other gender identifying and/or non gender identifying sexworkers, but offer our support to all workers in the Sex Industry on issues of human rights, civil liberties and pro choice.

RAMS makes it clear that our philosophy and practice of service delivery is not in anyway gender exclusive and that although we are specifically a service aimed to meet the needs of male sexworkers, female, transsexual, transgender, other gender identifying and non gender identifying workers are invited to utilise what ever services and resources we have that may be of benefit to them.
